Apple threatened by competition; US jobs data boosts optimism

Apple Inc. lost 2.6% last Friday to end the week down 8.9% as competition heats up. China Mobile Ltd, China's largest mobile carrier, recently agreed to carry Nokia's Lumia 920T. There are also concerns on Apple losing market share to Google in tablets. Still, the S&P 500 (+0.3%) and the Dow Jones Industrial Average (+0.6%) ended higher at 1,418.07 and 13,155.10, respectively due to positive economic data. Employment climbed by 146,000 in November and the jobless rate declined to an almost four-year low of 7.7 percent.

San Miguel, Ayala and Aboitiz to bid in Mactan-Cebu Airport

San Miguel Corp. intends to join the bidding for the construction of the P10B Mactan-Cebu airport. In a separate disclosure, conglomerates Ayala Corp. (AC) and Aboitiz Equity Ventures, Inc. through its subsidiary Aboitiz Land, Inc. signed a memorandum of agreement with Houston Airport System (HAS) and Airport Development Corporation (ADC) to form a consortium that will also participate in the rehabilitation, construction, and operation of the airport.

MGI signs contract with MIESCOR

Maibarara Geothermal Inc., a joint venture between Trans-Asia Oil and Energy Development Corp (25%), PNOC Renewables Corp. (10%) and PetroGreen Energy Corp (65%), has signed an Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) contract with Meralco Industrial Engineering Corp. (MIESCOR) last Dec 5, 2012. Under the EPC, MIESCOR will design, supply, deliver, install and test the 115 kV transmission line of the Maibarara Geothermal Power Project.

PHES inks deal with Ayala Land subsidiary

➤ Philippine Estates Corp (PHES) has signed a Memorandum of Agreement with Amaia Land Corp., subsidiary of Ayala Land Inc. to develop the former's real estate property in Cavite into a residential space.

EG trading halt

➤ IP E-Games Ventures. Inc.'s (EG) Board of Directors approved the issuance and listing of 3.75B shares at P0.0307 per share pursuant to the share lending transaction agreement with GEM Global Yield Fund Limited, GEM Investment Advisors, Inc. and Elite Holdings, Inc. A trading halt will be implemented today at 9 am and will be lifted at 10 am.

Agrinurture to enter into joint venture

Agrinurture, Inc., through wholly-owned subsidiary M2000 IMEX Company, Inc. (IMEX), is planning to enter a joint venture with Tolman Manufacturing, Inc. for the management and operation of a packaging line for coconut water. IMEX will contribute a UHT Processing Equipment, an Aseptic Filling Equipment and working capital.
